### Interreligious Affairs Department, August 2008 David Rosen

Having concluded in the first week of August the very successful US Christian leadership Institute (held in Jerusalem together with the Shalom Hartman Institute) Rabbi Gary Greenebaum was away on vacation for the rest of the month.

As I did not travel abroad in August, this report offers me an opportunity to provide some insight into events of note in my regular activity when I am in Israel (and on which I do not normally report, as I usually focus on the major international interfaith events in which I am involved) :-

## 3<sup>rd</sup>

- Interviewed by the Christian Embassy (the Jerusalem center for Evangelical support of Israel) for syndicated US Evangelical radio stations, on the Saudi Arabian Interreligious conference and on Jewish-Evangelical relations.
- Meeting with Ambassador Shmuel Hadas, to plan the Emerging Leadership conference of the ILC (IJCIC-Vatican) to be held in Italy next June .
- Briefing provided to Yoav Stern of Haaretz ,at his request , on the Saudi Arabian conference.

### $4^{\text{th}}$

- All day planning meeting in Ussefiya, Mt. Carmel, of the Steering Committee of the newly formed Israeli Council of Religious Leaders (as opposed to the Council of the religious Institutions of the Holy land which involves the Chief Rabbinate of Israel and the Palestinian Muslim and Christian leadership, this Council is made up of the official leaders of the recognized religious communities in Israel) for an event to be held in November.

- Meeting with President Peres' advisor on Interfaith Relations.
- Address a special educational seminar for Israeli resident SLA (South Lebanon Army) families, on Jewish-Christian relations.

Brief "Eagles Wings" US "young diplomats" mission on the Saudi Arabian Conference.

### 7<sup>th</sup>

- Meeting with the Zvil-Mezbuz Rebbe, Rabbi Korff, to brief him at his request on the Saudi Arabian conference.
- Meeting with Cardinal McCarrick, Ambassador Munzer Fatfat and David Austin (aide to Ambassador Tony Hall), to discuss the Council of the Religious Institutions of the Holy Land.

- Receive the Mayor of Gibraltar, Solomon Levy, to discuss Gibraltarian Jewish involvement in the ME Council of Religions for Peace.

- Recieve Dr. Enrico Molinari of Rome to discuss the subject of the Holy Sites.
