June 4-6, USA

June 30/July 1, Rhodes

A historic Jewish-Muslim gathering convened by Jews of Libyan and Iraqi origin took place on the island of Rhodes. Some two hundred people participated in the event including ministers and parliamentarians from Libya and Iraq as well as Israeli government ministers and leaders of the opposition . I was invited to address the gathering on the subject of Jewish-Muslim relations and on the importance and potential of interreligious diplomacy.



July 3rd, Jerusalem

The special conference of the Scholas Occurrentes, the international consortium of universities initiated by Pope Francis to promote a sustainable universal culture of peace, was hosted at the Truman Institute of the Hebrew University and attended by students and faculty members from universities around the world.
